

NORM-BASED ENGAGEMENT: INCIDENT-DRIVEN, QUARTERLY CYCLE INITIATIONS

THEMATIC ENGAGEMENT: TWO-YEAR ENGAGEMENT LIFE-CYCLE





NORM-BASED ENGAGEMENT HIGHLIGHT - SIPEF SA/NV

LABOUR STANDARDS, INDONESIA

SIPEF's local subsidiary allegedly **subjected workers to precarious working terms and conditions** at its oil palm plantations in Indonesia.

Dialogue focused on **implementation of remediation measures** identified through **mediation process** with Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil.

TIMELINE:

- July 2021: Norm-Based Engagement initiated
- December 2021: Company response after escalation to CEO
- February 2022: Constructive engagement meeting
- August 2022: Controversy assessment upgraded to Green and engagement closed



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NORM-BASED ENGAGEMENT OVERVIEW

GLOBAL IN SCOPE

- Engagements are carried out for approximately 100 public companies per year.
- Focuses on companies identified under Norm-Based Research as failing to prevent or address social and environmental controversies in line with established standards for Responsible Business Conduct (Red/Amber flagged).




